WITNESS STATEMENT OF JOHNSON ASIEDU NKETIAH

- 1. My name is Johnson Asiedu Nketiah and I live at No. C/3 Community 13, Tema, in the Greater Accra Region of the Republic of Ghana.
- 2. I am the General Secretary of the National Democratic Congress (NDC), the political party on whose ticket Petitioner contested as candidate for the office of President in the Presidential Election held on 7th December 2020. I testify in support of Petitioner's case as contained in his Petition.

- 3. 1st Respondent is the body mandated by the 1992 Constitution to conduct and supervise all public elections and referenda. The Returning Officer for the Presidential Election was Mrs. Jean Adukwei Mensa, 1st Respondent's Chairperson.
- 4. 2nd Respondent was the candidate for the office of President in the Presidential Election on the ticket of the New Patriotic Party (NPP).
- 5. There were other candidates in the said Presidential Election, representing other political parties, while one person stood as an independent candidate. They are listed below:

Christian Kwabena Andrews - Ghana Union Movement

(GUM)

Ivor Kwabena Greenstreet - Convention People's Party

(CPP)

Akua Donkor - Ghana Freedom Party (GFP)

Henry Herbert Lartey - Great Consolidated Popular

Party (GCPP)

Hassan Ayariga - All People's Congress (APC)

Percival Kofi Akpaloo - Liberal Party of Ghana

(LPG)

David Asibi Ayindenaba Apasera - People's National

Convention (PNC)

Brigitte Akosua Dzogbenuku - Progressive People's Party

(PPP)

Nana Konadu Agyeman Rawlings - National Democratic Party

(NDP)

Alfred Kwame Asiedu Walker - Independent Candidate.

- 6. Petitioner has caused to be filed a "REQUEST TO ADMIT FACTS" directed at 1st Respondent. I am informed by Petitioner's lawyers that, as at the time I am signing this Witness Statement, 1st Respondent has not responded to the Request. I am advised by Counsel and verily believe that the response of 1st Respondent or lack thereof to the "REQUEST TO ADMIT FACTS" is likely to require a further Witness Statement from me.
- 7. Lawyers for the Petitioner also applied for leave to serve interrogatories on the 1st Respondent. The court dismissed the application and an application for review of the said decision is currently pending. Should the court allow any interrogatories to be served, responses provided

may also be relevant evidence which may require a further Witness Statement.

- 8. On 9th December 2020, Mrs. Jean Adukwei Mensa, Chairperson of 1st Respondent and the Returning Officer for the Presidential Election, held a press conference at which she purported to declare 2nd Respondent duly elected as President. The so-called declaration was broadcast live on radio, television and other electronic media. Attached to this Witness Statement and marked as **Exhibit "A"** is a video and audio recording of the so-called declaration.
- 9. In purporting to declare the results, Mrs. Jean Adukwei Mensa, Chairperson of 1st Respondent and the Returning Officer for the Presidential Election, said:

"At the end of the transparent, fair, orderly, timely and peaceful Presidential Elections, the total number of valid votes cast was 13,434,574 representing 79% of the total registered voters."

- 10. She further said that 2nd Respondent of the NPP obtained **6,730,413** votes, being **51.595**% of the total valid votes cast. The claim that the percentage of votes obtained by 2nd Respondent was **51.595**% of the total valid votes cast that she herself distinctly stated to have been **13,434,574**, was a manifest error, as votes cast for 2nd Respondent would amount to **50.098**% and not the **51.595**% she erroneously declared.
- 11. Mrs. Jean Adukwei Mensa, Chairperson of 1st Respondent and the Returning Officer for the Presidential Election, further declared that:

"John Dramani Mahama of the NDC obtained 6,214,889 votes, being 47.366% of the total valid votes cast."

12. In purporting to declare 2nd Respondent as the winner of the Presidential Election, Mrs. Jean Adukwei Mensa, also stated that:

"Currently the election results we have declared exclude that of the Techiman South Constituency, with a voter population of 128,018. The said election results are not ready because they are being contested Even if we were to add the 128,018 full results to the results of the second candidate, it would not change the outcome of the election, hence our declaration of the 2020 presidential results without that of Techiman South".

13. The Techiman South Constituency has a total registered voter population of 128,018, and if added to the total valid votes announced by

Mrs. Jean Adukwei Mensa as cast (13,434,574), the resultant figure would now be 13,562,592. Consequently, if all the votes of Techiman South Constituency were added to Petitioner's votes, 2nd Respondent's votes would remain the same at 6,730,413, now yielding 49.625%, while the votes of Petitioner would increase to 6,342,907, now yielding 46.768%.

- 14. When the percentages of valid votes cast and standing to the names of each of the Presidential Candidates and as purportedly declared by Mrs. Jean Adukwei Mensa on 9th December 2020 are summed up, they would yield a total of one hundred point three per cent (100.3%), a mathematical and statistical impossibility.
- 15. Article 63(3) of the 1992 Constitution provides that:

"A person shall not be elected as President of Ghana unless at the presidential election the number of votes cast in his favour is more than fifty percent of the total number of valid votes cast at the election."

The Public Elections Regulations, 2020 (C.I. 127), also reflected this provision of the Constitution in Regulation 44(1).

- 16. Accordingly, based on the figures that the Chairperson of 1st Respondent, Mrs. Jean Adukwei Mensa, announced as part of her declaration, she acted in flagrant violation of the 1992 Constitution.
- 17. Article 63 (4) further provides that: "Where at a presidential election there are more than two candidates and no candidates obtains the number or percentage of votes specified in clause (3) of this article a second election shall be held within twenty-one days after the previous election."

The Public Elections Regulations, 2020 (C.I. 127), also reflected this provision of the Constitution in Regulation 44(1).

- 18. Accordingly, based on the figures that Mrs. Jean Adukwei Mensa, Chairperson of 1st Respondent and the Returning Officer for the Presidential Election, announced in her declaration of the results of the Presidential Election, she was required to conduct a second election between Petitioner and 2nd Respondent.
- 19. On 10th December 2020, in an unsigned Press Release issued in the name of 1st Respondent, it was claimed that its Chairperson, Mrs. Jean Adukwei Mensa, had "*inadvertently*" used the figure 13,433,573 for the total valid

votes cast. The said release claimed that "The total valid votes cast is now 13,119,460."

- 20. In this unsigned press release, 1st Respondent introduced new figures for the total valid votes cast in the Presidential Election held on 7th December 2020. A copy of the said press release is attached and marked as **Exhibit "B"**, and was available on 1st Respondent's website, www.ec.gov.gh as of 11:45 hours GMT on 29th December 2020.
- 21. Following that, the results being published by 1st Respondent on its website, <u>www.ec.gov.gh</u>, became moving targets. 1st Respondent subsequently deleted the changing figures from its website.
- 22. There has, to date, been no other declaration of the results of the Presidential Election by the Chairperson of the Electoral Commission, who is, solely, the Returning Officer for the Presidential Election, other than her declaration of 9th December 2020.
- 23. There has, to date, also been no process whereby the Chairperson of the 1st Respondent and the Returning Officer for the Presidential Election, conferred with any agents of the Petitioner, as well as for other candidates, to notify them of any corrections that were required to be made in respect of the figures that she announced on the 9th December 2020, as the basis for the declaration she made.
- 24. In announcing the various so-called "corrections" and "corrections" of "corrections", no officer of 1st Respondent engaged in any consultative process involving Petitioner or his accredited agents, nor did Mrs. Jean Adukwei Mensa, Returning Officer for the Presidential Election, or 1st Respondent, notify Petitioner or his agents that there was a reasonable basis to revise the figures as to the votes he (Petitioner) and/or 2nd Respondent obtained, much less give them an opportunity to observe or participate in the processes by which those revisions were purportedly effected.
- 25. This was clearly contrary to the responsibilities the Chairperson of the 1st Respondent, and 1st Respondent as a whole, had by virtue of Article 23 of the Constitution which provides that: "Administrative bodies and administrative officials shall act fairly and reasonably and comply with the requirements imposed by law and persons aggrieved by the exercise of such acts and decisions shall have the right to seek redress before a court or other tribunal." In fact, the ever-changing figures put out in the unsigned press releases and what was posted on the website

of the 1st Respondent in respect of the declaration of the Presidential Election, betrayed the determination on the part of Mrs. Jean Adukwei Mensa as Returning Officer for the Presidential Election, and certain officials of 1st Respondent, to have 2nd Respondent installed as President of Ghana on 7th January 2021 by hook or by crook.

- 26. The Chairperson of 1st Respondent and 1st Respondent are also not required under Article 296 of the Constitution to be "biased either by resentment, prejudice or personal dislike" in exercising any discretionary power, but they are required to exercise such powers "in accordance with due process of law". The Chairperson of 1st Respondent, Mrs. Jean Adukwei Mensa, allowed herself to be biased by her prejudice in favour of 2nd Respondent, who appointed her in August 2018 and with whose wife Mrs. Jean Adukwei Mensa has a close familial relationship. Mrs. Mensa was thus, at all material times in the conduct of her responsibilities, biased by prejudice in favour of the 2nd Respondent and against the Petitioner.
- 27. If Mrs. Jean Adukwei Mensa, as Returning Officer for the Presidential Election, had determined in good faith that her declaration on 9th December 2020 was in error, her constitutional duty to be fair and candid required her, among other things, to acknowledge the error, set aside her erroneous declaration and proceed on the path to correcting her error, respecting the rights of all candidates, including Petitioner, to participate in the processes towards the making of such a correction.
- 28. It is clear that, in seeking to justify the new figures put forward in the press release of 10th December 2020, one or more officials of 1st Respondent made various adjustments to figures of votes cast for various candidates on their own, in the absence of representatives of Petitioner, and without any explanation whatsoever to Petitioner or his agents or, indeed, to the Ghanaian public. The secrecy and lack of transparency regarding figures thrown up by one or more officials of 1st Respondent seeking to justify, after the event, Mrs. Jean Adukwei Mensa's 9th December 2020 purported declaration, undermines the whole attempt at "correction" of what was indisputably an error-ridden declaration, and shows that figures were simply being cooked to achieve a pre-determined outcome that had nothing to do with actual votes cast in the Presidential Election for the various candidates.

- 29. In no previous Presidential Election in the Fourth Republic in Ghana has there been such a catalogue of admitted errors as in what happened after the 7th December 2020 Presidential Election. In all previous Presidential Elections, results collated at each constituency collation centre were transmitted directly by fax from 1st Respondent's regional offices (without collation), to what is usually referred to as the "strongroom" at its head office in Accra, and handed over to the representatives of the candidates, for them to scrutinize and then certify. In those previous Presidential Elections, when 1st Respondent declared the final results, they were based on the collated results from the constituencies which were duly certified by representatives of the candidates in the "strongroom".
- 30. In the new Regulations promulgated by 1st Respondent, C.I. 127, it now interposed between the "strongroom" and the constituency collation centres, without any good reason, another layer of collation at its regional offices, with regional summary sheets. This led to results being sent from Regional Collation centres which were at variance with the results collated at constituency collation centres, as a result of figures being altered by officials of 1st Respondent. Exhibit "C" provides sample details of wrong aggregation of valid votes on the face of the summary sheets (Form 10) of some 11 constituencies. The exhibit shows that the sum total of valid votes obtained by all candidates varies from the figure recorded on the face of the summary sheets as the total valid votes from each of those constituencies.
- 31. After the 7th December 2020 Presidential Election, Petitioner's representatives in the "strongroom" discovered that there were errors, as a result of which they did not certify the summary of the results from some of the regions. They also noticed anomalies with some of the collation sheets that may have been inputted into the results. Based on their observations, NDC caused a letter to be written to 1st Respondent detailing some of their concerns (Exhibit "D"), which the Chairperson of 1st Respondent, Mrs. Jean Adukwei Mensa, obviously in a hurry to declare the election for 2nd Respondent, refused to accept. In the absence of Petitioner's representatives, she declared the final results in favour of 2nd Respondent.
- 32. Indeed, aggregating the total valid votes as shown by the 275 summary sheets released by 1st Respondent on its website, the resultant figure is actually 13,218,076, which is different from the 9th December 2020 purported declaration of Mrs. Jean Adukwei Mensa, the Returning Officer of the Presidential Election.

- 33. The aggregated figure from the total valid votes as shown by the 275 summary sheets released by 1st Respondent on its website, 13,218,633, is also different from the "corrected" figure of 10th December 2020 in the unsigned press release of 1st Respondent.
- 34. The aggregated figure from the total valid votes as shown by the 275 summary sheets released by 1st Respondent on its website, 13,218,633, is again different from the figure stated in paragraph 24 of 1st Respondent's Answer filed on 9th January 2021. Attached and marked as **Exhibit "E"** is a spreadsheet of the results released by the 1st Respondent on its website and the arithmetical calculation resulting from those figures.
- 35. The figures provided by 1st Respondent for CPP, APC, LPG, PPP and the Independent Candidate also showed discrepancies between the announced regional totals and the constituency totals. All these discrepancies in all instances, materially increased the votes of the 2nd Respondent, while at the same time materially reducing the votes of Petitioner.
- 36. Exhibit "F" is a spreadsheet covering sample details from 26 constituencies showing vote padding by certain officials of 1st Respondent in favour of 2nd Respondent. When the votes 2nd Respondent obtained in all polling stations as shown on their respective pink sheets in these 26 constituencies are aggregated, the resultant figure differs from the figure that was declared by 1st Respondent for 2nd Respondent as captured on the summary sheets of the respective constituencies. They show that more votes were added to those of 2nd Respondent than he had, in fact, obtained.
- 37. This conduct of certain officials of 1st Respondent in padding the votes of 2nd Respondent, is in fact, indicative of a well hatched and sustained pattern of manufacturing numbers, unrelated to the actual votes collated at the various collation centres, with the sole aim of achieving the pre-determined goal of the Chairperson of the 1st Respondent, and a number of officials of the 1st Respondent, to have 2nd Respondent unconstitutionally and unlawfully installed as President of Ghana.
- 38. The figures underpinning the purported declaration of 9th December 2020 and the "corrections" as well as the "corrections of the correction" was unwittingly confirmed by no other person than 2nd Respondent's representative in Court, who was also his Campaign Manager for the 7th December 2020 Presidential Election, Mr. Mac Manu, who claimed, after

Respondents had been served with the Petition, that Petitioner also benefitted from vote-padding by 1st Respondent. A clip of his interview is attached to this witness statement and marked as **Exhibit "G"**.

- 39. The Chairperson of the 1st Respondent has, subsequent to her purported declaration on 9th December 2020, purported to gazette the declaration she made on 9th December 2020 by publishing the **Declaration of President-Elect Instrument, 2020 (C.I. 135)**, claiming that 2nd Respondent was the winner of the Presidential Election on the basis of him having obtained more than 50% of the valid votes cast. A copy of C.I. 135 is attached to this witness statement and marked as **Exhibit "H"**.
- 40. The gazette notification of the outcome of the Presidential Election was based on the declaration actually made on 9th December 2020 by Mrs. Jean Adukwei Mensa as the Chairperson of 1st Respondent and the Returning Officer of the Presidential Election. The said gazette notification, being notification of the unconstitutional, error-ridden publicly broadcast declaration made by Mrs. Jean Adukwei Mensa on the evening of 9th December 2020, is, therefore, also unconstitutional.
- 41. Only actual valid votes cast, counted and featured in the collation of the 7th December 2020 Presidential Election could be reflected in any constitutionally valid and legitimate declaration of results by the Chairperson of the Electoral Commission. Any changes or corrections to figures announced would also have to reflect those votes. The basis of a declaration of the election results cannot, and should not, be manufactured or be the result of strained mathematical adjustments of vote numbers and percentages in support of an erroneous premise, just to maintain what is indisputably an error-ridden declaration by the Returning Officer, Mrs. Jean Adukwei Mensa.
- 42. To uphold the Constitution of Ghana, it is clearly necessary for this Court to set aside the error-ridden and unconstitutional declaration made on 9th December 2020 by the Chairperson of 1st Respondent and the Returning Officer for the Presidential Election, Mrs. Jean Adukwei Mensa, and in respect of the Presidential Election of 7th December 2020.



PETITION AGAINST IRREGULARITIES IN THE PRESIDENTIAL AND PARLIAMENTARY ELECTIONS

The National Democratic Congress (NDG) hereby petitions your office regarding the December 7, 2020 Presidential and Parliamentary elections.

It has come to our notice that there are irregularities surrounding the conduct of the 7th December 2020 Parliamentary and Presidential Elections which have adversely impacted the fortunes of our party and completely undermined the credibility of the elections. By this Petition, we request that you investigate our complaints before declaring your final results. While the complaints in this our Petition are not exhaustive, we make specific reference to the following:

- (a) In the Eastern Region, the results in the Presidential Elections which were collated and signed by all the parties were not the ones that were transmitted from the Region to the Electoral Commission offices in Accra (APPENDIX A)
- (b) Ashanti Region provides fundamental problems that require investigation. We have found out that almost across board, the aggregates on the summary sheet do not reflect the individual results on the pink sheets. Further, the results collated and declared for the region do not reflect the aggregate results on the pink sheets in our custody.

You may also recall that prior to December 7, 2020, there were complaints that ballot papers thumb-printed for Candidate Nana Akuffo Addo were found at various

locations. The results in Ashanti Region in many constituencies show massive differences between the Parliamentary and Presidential votes, in some cases running into tens of thousands more in the Presidential elections. In Bantama for instance, it was noticed that the portion of the pink sheets reserved for recording the number of persons biometrically verified was not filled on a large number of pink sheets. When our agents requested for the biometric machines to confirm the recorded results, they were denied access, with the explanation that they were recorded in a book, access to which was also denied them.

- (c) Regarding the Parliamentary Elections, the irregularities are simply criminal.
 - (i) In Tarkwa, for instance, the initial collation showed that NDC won. However 4 additional collations were done at gun-point, the first three in favour of the NDC candidate. The fourth one reversed the trend and the results were declared in favour of NPP.
 - (ii) In Sefwi Wiawso, results were declared without one ballot box being counted. The parties had agreed that an issue of alleged over-voting should be referred to the collation centre to be resolved. The ballot box disappeared enroute the collation centre. And yet results were declared in favour of the NPP Candidate.
 - (iii) In Upper Denkyira West, the EC officer has not declared the results because of threats of death. The results favour the NDC candidate.
 - (iv) In Sene West, a ballot box was snatched and the culprit apprehended. The seal of the NPP must have dislodged in the ensuing scuffle. That of NDC and the Electoral Commission were intact. However NPP would not allow the ballot box to be counted and added to the lot because it would obviously favour the NDC.
 - (v) In Techiman South, the NDC won, but the military was invited and in the ensuing scuffle two people were killed. The results have now been declared for the NPP.
- (d) One matter requires special mention. The use of the military in these elections is unprecedented. They featured heavily in these elections as an intimidating force to reverse election results, and continue to be used in the same intimidating role to insist on recounts and to intimidate election officers.

As already indicated, the above are not exhaustive.

By this Petition, we request that, in the spirit of transparency and fairness, you invite all the parties to your offices to resolve these problems before declaring the results. We will bring along the necessary documentation in support of our complaint.
